

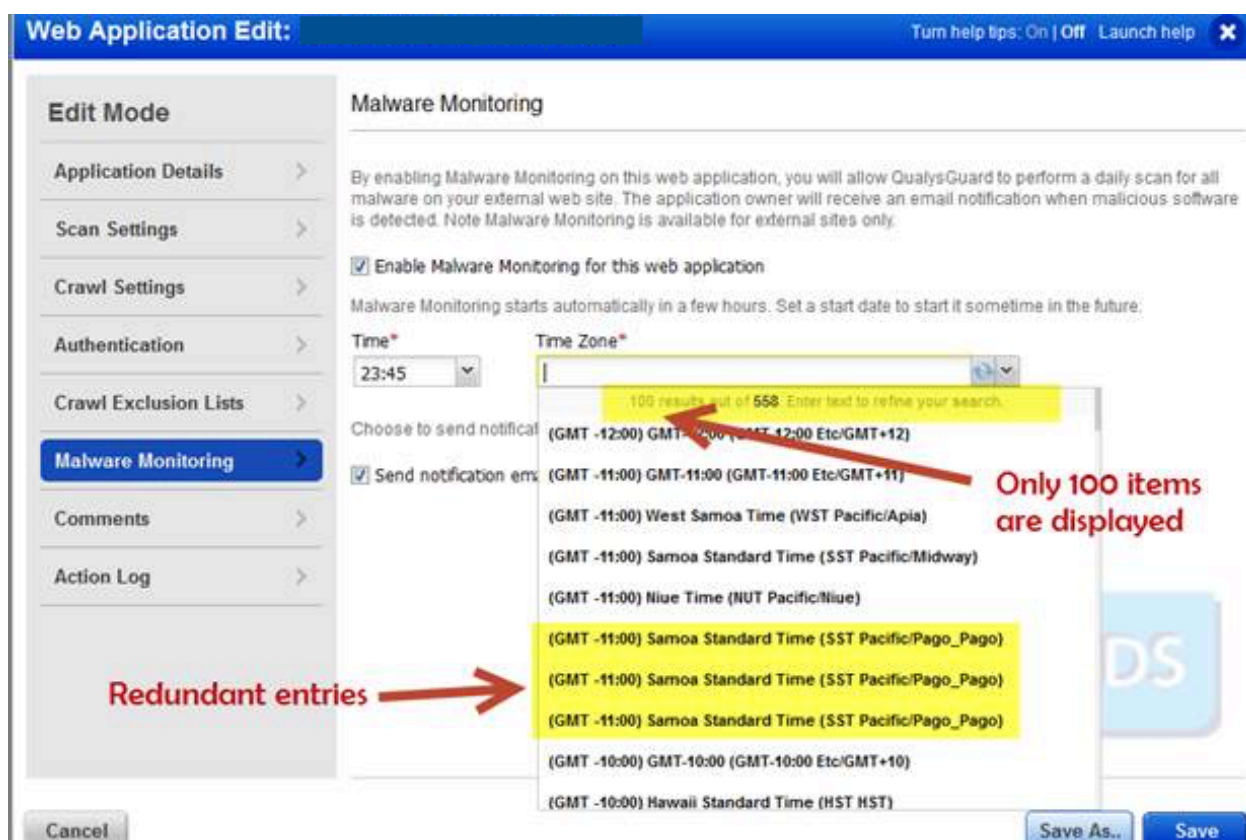


Malware Detection 2.11

Malware Detection 2.11 has fixed the time zone feature and removed redundant time zones for easier MD scan scheduling capabilities.

Previously, there was a limit of only viewing 100 of the total global time zones as well as several redundant time zones listed that caused some users to lose valuable time and make finding your desired time zone difficult.

The old issue in the user interface below, has been fixed.
